

## REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

### BYLAW NO. 1202

---

Being a bylaw to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Noxious Insect and Pest Infestation Control Bylaw No. 879, 2000.

---

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan has enacted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Noxious Insect and Pest Infestation Control Bylaw No. 879, 2000;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable and expedient to amend the said Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Regional District of Central Okanagan Noxious Insect and Pest Infestation Bylaw No. 879 is hereby amended as follows:
  - a. Under Section 1. **Control an infestation** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“**Control an infestation** shall mean procedures which are recognized by the Ministry of Agriculture, and the tree fruit, forestry or horticultural industries as responsible best management practices for controlling specific noxious or destructive insects, related pests, or other growths, diseases or related disorders, such as application of an appropriate chemical or biological spray, removal of the noxious or destructive insects, related pests or other growths, diseases or related disorders, and removal of the infested or infected trees, bushes, plants, plant parts or fruit.”
  - b. Under Section 1. **Infested/infestation** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“**Infested/infestation** shall mean the presence of populations of noxious or destructive insects, related pests, or other growths, diseases or related disorders, in trees, bushes, plants or fruit that have caused or are likely to cause significant damage to the infested/infected trees, bushes, plants or fruit, and to any similar nearby trees, bushes, plants or fruit.”
  - c. Under Section 1. **Noxious or destructive insects and pests** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“**Noxious or destructive insects or related pests** shall mean:

    - Codling moth – *Cydial pomonells* (L.)
    - Western cherry fruit fly – *Rhagoletis indifferens* Curran
    - Black cherry fruit fly – *Rhagoletis fausta* (O.S.)
    - Pear psylla – *Cacopsylla pyricola* Foerst
    - Apple-and-thorn skeletonizer – *Choreutis pariana* (Cl.)

- Apple ermine moth – Yponomeuta malinella Zell.
- Gypsy Moth – Lymantria dispar (L.)
- Apple maggot – Rhagoletis pomonella (Walsh)
- Oriental fruit moth – Grapholita molesta (Bst.)
- Cherry bark tortrix – Enarmonia formosana (Scop.)
- Cherry ermine moth – Yponomeuta padellus (L.)
- Plum curculio (Conotrachelus nenuphar)

Leafroller family – Tortricidae, any of the following:

- Fruittree leafroller – Archips argyrospila (Wik.)
- European leafroller – Archips rosana (L.)
- Obliquebanded leafroller – Choristoneura rosaceana (Harr.)
- Threelined leafroller – Pandemis limitata (Rob.)
- Eyespotted budmoth – Spilonota ocellana (Dyar & Shannon)

Other noxious or destructive insects or related pests that are identified as potential or recently introduced invasive alien species by the B.C. Ministry of Agriculture and Lands.”

d. Under Section 1. Add the following new definition:

**“Other growths, diseases or related disorders** shall mean:

- Fire Blight – Erwinia amylovora
- Apple Scab – Venturia inaequalis
- Brown Rot – Monolinia fructicola
- Phytophthora Blight – Phytophthora capsici

Other growths, diseases or related disorders that are identified as potential or recently introduced invasive species by the B.C. Ministry of Agriculture and Lands.”

4. This bylaw may be cited as the “Regional District of Central Okanagan Noxious Insect and Pest Infestation Control Amendment Bylaw No. 1202, 2007.”
