## REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

### BYLAW NO. 404 - CONSOLIDATED

---

Being a bylaw to provide fire protection to a portion of Central Okanagan East Electoral Area

---

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The fire protection specified area created under Bylaw No. 140, cited as the "Joe Rich Fire Protection Specified Area Establishment and Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 140, 1977", as amended by Bylaw Nos. 230, 271, 291, 305, 308 and 341, is hereby established as a local service for that portion of Electoral Area 'I' shown outlined on the plan attached, as Schedule 'A', to this bylaw and known as the Joe Rich Fire Protection Local Service Area.
  - a. To carry out all fire protection activities within the service area including, but not limited to,
    - i. Fire suppression Bylaw No.
    - ii. Rescue Bylaw No. 413
    - iii. Disaster planning Bylaw No.
    - iv. Medical First Responder Program Bylaw No.
  - b. The Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan may enter into mutual aid agreements respecting the use of equipment and personnel to provide assistance inside or outside of the service area, to the specific clause of circumstances set out in Clause 1 of this bylaw that may cause harm to persons and property. Bylaw No. 413
2. The maximum amount that may be expended for annual operating costs for the service provided under Section One shall not exceed \$2.50 per \$1,000.00 of net taxable value of land and improvements within the service area. Bylaw No. 420
3. The annual operating costs and debt servicing costs shall be recovered by requisition of monies to be collected by a property value tax levied on land and improvements for regional hospital purposes, within the service area.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Joe Rich Fire Protection Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 404, 1989".
