#### **Demolition Permit Process**


Demolition Permit Application submitted to Inspection Services office or online at <u>requests.rdco.com</u>

Demolition permit fee waived on McDougall Creek wildfire damaged properties.

Completed demolition subject to site inspection and final approval.

\*\*Note: It is advisable to consult with Planning and Inspections staff to review proposed development prior to submission of building permit application.

### **Temporary RV Use Permit Process**

Temporary RV Use permit for McDougall Creek wildfire damaged properties. Once the Single Family Dwelling permit has been issued and active construction is occurring, the applicant may apply for a temporary RV Use permit to allow the temporary placement of an RV onsite for use as a temporary dwelling during construction (2-year max). Fees waived.
